AN ORDINANCE

Amending Various Section 9-5-10(D) of the Evanston City Code Pertaining to Fines for Alcohol Consumption / Possession on Public Property

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF **EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:**

SECTION 1: That Section 9-5-10(D) of the City Code of the City of Evanston, 1979, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

9-5-10: ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; CONSUMPTION / POSSESSION ON **PUBLIC PROPERTY:**

Violation: Any person found violating any of the provisions of this section shall be fined not less than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) nor more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for each offense.

This section shall not be construed to prohibit the possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages within public buildings, on streets, alleys, sidewalks, parkways and public parking lots in conjunction with an authorized event where such event and use of said alcoholic beverages has been disclosed in writing to and authorized by the city manager.

SECTION 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
