### **AN ORDINANCE**

# Authorizing the City Manager to Execute an Easement Agreement with Howard Station, JV, LLC, for Footings (Caisson Bells) at 415 Howard Street

WHEREAS, the City of Evanston ("City") and Howard Station, JV, LLC, ("Howard Station") desire to enter into an Easement Agreement for the installation of the footings (caisson bells) in the public right-of-way adjacent to 415 Howard Street as shown on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, Howard Station has entered into a contract to purchase the property located at 415 Howard Street; and

WHEREAS, Howard Station has entered into a redevelopment agreement with the City and intends to build a two hundred twenty-one (221) -unit residential apartment building with parking at 415 Howard Street; and

WHEREAS, the footings (caisson bells) of certain foundations required to support the building will be installed in the public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the footings (caisson bells) are located so as to encroach on the City's public right-of-way to a maximum of three (3) feet along the south property line, for a distance of two hundred eighty-one feet (281') along Howard Street to a maximum of three (3) feet along the east property line for a distance of one hundred one feet (101') along the alley to be dedicated by Howard Station,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

**SECTION 1:** That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to sign, and the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest on behalf of the City of Evanston, an Easement Agreement, for the term of ninety-nine (99) years and the sum of six thousand four hundred seventy six and no/100 dollars (\$6,476.00), between the City of Evanston and Howard Station providing for the installation of footings (caisson bells) in the public right-of-way as set forth on Exhibit A.

**SECTION 2:** That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to negotiate any additional terms and conditions of the Easement Agreement as may be determined to be in the best interests of the City.

**SECTION 3:** That this Ordinance or parts of ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
