AN ORDINANCE

Amending Section 3-16-5 of the City Code of the City of Evanston (Prohibiting the Sale of Tobacco Products Within One Hundred Fifty Feet of a
High School or Middle School)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That Section 3-16-5 of the Evanston City Code of 1979,

as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

3-16-5 (A) LOCATION RESTRICTIONS:

It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, offer for sale, give away, or deliver tobacco products within one hundred fifty feet (150') as measured from lot line to lot line of any high school, middle school or elementary school except for the Park School and Rice Children's Center of the Evanston/Skokie School District 65 Special Schools and Centers.

3-16-5 (B) PENALTY:

Any person violating this section 3-16-5 shall be fined not less than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense, one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) for the second offense and license revocation for the third offense. In addition to any other penalty, a licensee, or any agent of a licensee, convicted of violating any provision of this section may be subject licensee to having his/her license revoked, suspended or not renewed by the public health director. For purposes of this ordinance, a clerk or salesperson is considered an agent of the licensee.

SECTION 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict

herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
