SECTION 1: That Title 10, Chapter 11 of the Evanston City Code of 1979, as amended, is hereby further amended by revising Subsection 10-11-12(A) to read as follows:

(A) Two (2) hour maximum parking limit at rate of seventy-five cents (\$0.75) per hour, between the hours of eight o'clock (8:00) A.M. to nine o'clock (9:00) P.M.:
