## Amending the City Code by Adding Subsection 3-5-4(L), "INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

**SECTION 1:** That Section 3-5-4 of the Evanston City Code of 1979, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

## 3-5-4 (L) INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:

(L) Before any liquor license shall be issued on such liquor license application and renewal, the applicant shall furnish a valid certificate of liquor liability (dram shop) insurance to the Local Liquor Control Commissioner. Such insurance policy shall cover the applicant, be issued by a responsible insurance company authorized and licensed to do business in the State of Illinois, and specifically naming the City of Evanston as an additional insured in the aggregated amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00). The insurance policy required by this Subsection shall be in effect prior to the issuance of any liquor license and be for a term of at least twelve (12) months, and shall coincide with the period the liquor license is in effect.

**SECTION 2:** That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3:** That if any provision of this Ordinance 28-O-09 or application thereof to any person or circumstance is held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance 28-O-09 that can be given effect without the invalid application or provision, and each invalid application of this Ordinance is severable.

**SECTION 4:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
