**AN ORDINANCE**

**Amending City Code Subsection 4-12-6-(S)  
to Remove Time Restrictions on Political or Campaign Signs**

**NOW BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:**

**SECTION 1:** That Subsection 4-12-6-(S) of the City Code is hereby further amended to read as follows:

**(S)** Political or Campaign Signs: Signs promoting candidates for public office or issues on election ballots, not exceeding six (6) square feet per occupancy, posted on private property.

**SECTION 2:** That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3:** That if any provision of this ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid application or provision, and each invalid application of this ordinance is severable.

**SECTION 4:** That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.


