AN ORDINANCE

Amending City Code Subsection 8-4-3(G), "Special Pick-Up Fee"

NOW BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That Subsection 8-4-3(G) of the Evanston City Code of 2012, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

(G) Special Pick-Up Fee: Any person who violates the provisions of this Section is subject to a fee of sixty dollars (\$60.00) for a "special pick-up" for the additional collection service resulting from the violations of the aforementioned Subsections. The fee will cover the collection, transportation and disposal of up to three (3) cubic yards of refuse, yard waste, or recyclable material. For each additional one (1) cubic yard of refuse, yard waste, or recyclable material in excess of the initial three (3) cubic yards, an additional ten dollars (\$10.00) will be charged. The Director of Public Works or his/her designee may increase the total fee as described by Section 8-4-9-1(G) to address the City's costs for the special pick-up.

SECTION 2: The findings and recitals contained herein are declared to be prima facie evidence of the law of the City and shall be received in evidence as provided by the Illinois Complied Statues and the courts of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on June 1, 2016, after its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 5: If any provision of this ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is ruled unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect

without the invalid application or provision, and each invalid provision or invalid application of this ordinance is severable.
