**AN ORDINANCE**

**Amending Various Sections of Title 10, Chapter 11, Section 12  
“Parking Meter Zones”**

**NOW BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:**

**SECTION 1:** Schedule XII, “Parking Meter Zones,” of Section 10-11-12(B), of the Evanston City Code of 2012, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

- (B) Two (2) hour maximum parking limit at a rate of one dollar (\$1.00) per hour, between the hours of eight o'clock (8:00) A.M. to nine o'clock (9:00) P.M.:

**SECTION 2:** Schedule XII, “Parking Meter Zones,” of Section 10-11-12(C), of the Evanston City Code of 2012, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

- (C) Two (2) hour maximum parking limit at rate of one dollar (\$1.00) per hour, between the hours of eight o'clock (8:00) A.M. to nine o'clock (9:00) P.M.:

**SECTION 3:** Schedule XII, “Parking Meter Zones,” of Section 10-11-12(H), of the Evanston City Code of 2012, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

**SECTION 4:** The findings and recitals contained herein are declared to be prima facie evidence of the law of the City and shall be received in evidence as provided by the Illinois Compiled Statutes and the courts of the State of Illinois.

**SECTION 5:** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 6:** This Ordinance 124-O-17 shall be in full force and effect on January 1, 2018, after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.

**SECTION 7:** If any provision of this ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is ruled unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid application or provision, and each invalid provision or invalid application of this ordinance is severable.


