## **AN ORDINANCE**

## Amending Various Sections of Title 10, Chapter 11 "Motor Vehicles and Traffic" Pertaining to Simpson Street

NOW BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:

**SECTION 1:** City Code Section 10-11-10 Schedule X(A) and X(B) of the

Evanston City Code of 2012, as amended, is hereby further amended:

In accordance with the provisions of Section 10-4-15-5 of this Title, parking shall be limited upon the days and between the hours and upon the streets or portions thereof listed hereafter:

SCHEDULE X (A): 30 MINUTE LIMITED PARKING			
(A)	minutes between the hours	No person shall park a motor vehicle for a period of time longer than thirty (30) ninutes between the hours of nine o'clock (9:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) P.M. on any day except Sunday and national holidays upon any of the following streets or portions thereof:	
	Lake Street	North side, Ashland Avenue to a point 150 feet east thereof	
	Simpson Street	North Side, Dewey Avenue to first alley west thereof	

SCHEDULE X (B): TWO-HOUR LIMITED PARKING			
(B)	No person shall park a motor vehicle for a period of time longer than two (2) hours between the hours of nine o'clock (9:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) P.M. on any day except Sunday and national holidays upon the following streets or portions thereof:		
	Simpson Street	North side, Dewey Avenue to Ashland Avenue

without the invalid application or provision, and each invalid application of this

Ordinance is severable.
