AN ORDINANCE

Amending Title 10, Chapter 11, Section 12(H) "Parking Zones"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: Schedule XII(H) of Section 10-11-12(H) of the Evanston City Code of 2012, as amended, is hereby amended as follows:

(H) The following City-owned and –operated parking lots are hereby declared to be parking meter zones for the maximum parking time limits, daily hours, and amounts hereinafter stated:

SCHEDULE XII (H):		
Parking lot #1, Hinman Avenue and South Boulevard:		
	up to 24 spaces	1. \$0.50 per hour
		Maximum limit, 15 hours
		8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday
		Overnight Parking Permitted

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: The findings in this Ordinance, and the legislative Record, are declared to be prima facie evidence of the law of the City of Evanston, and shall be received in evidence as provided by the Illinois Compiled Statutes and the courts of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 4: If any provision of this ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is ruled unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid application or provision, and each invalid provision or invalid application of this ordinance is severable.

SECTION 5: Ordinance 7-O-20 shall be in full force and effect after its passage and approval.

SECTION 5: The findings and recitals contained herein are declared to be prima facie evidence of the law of the City and shall be received in evidence as provided by the Illinois Compiled Statutes and the courts of the State of Illinois.
