INTRODUCTION

William Arndt, hereinafter sometimes referred to as the Objector, states as follows:

1. The Objector resides at 514 Ridge Ave., Evanston, Illinois, 60202, in the City of Evanston, State of Illinois, and is a duly qualified, legal and registered voter at that address.



WHEREFORE, the Objector requests: a) a hearing on the objections set forth herein; b) an examination by the aforesaid Electoral Board of the official records relating to voters in the City of Evanston, Illinois, to the extent that such examination is pertinent to any of the matters alleged herein; c) a ruling that the Nomination Papers are insufficient in law and fact, and d) a ruling that the name of Gary Gaspard shall not appear and not be printed on the ballot for election to the office of Mayor of the City of Evanston, Illinois, to be voted for at the Consolidated Primary Election to be held February 28, 2017, except that if no primary is required by law then the Consolidated Election to be held on April 4, 2017.

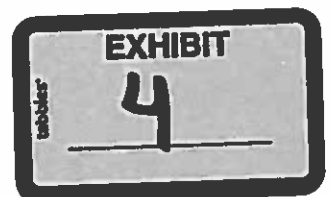

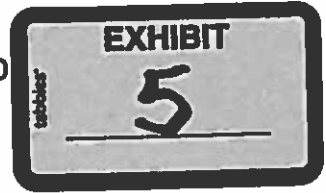

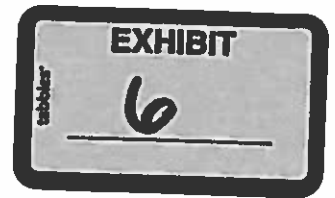

MEMORANDUM OF LAW IN SUPPORT OF OBJECTOR’S PETITION

NOW COMES Objector, William Arndt, by and through his attorney, Scott B. Erdman, P.C., and submits the following Memorandum of Law in Support of Objector’s Petition.

I. INTRODUCTION

Candidate, Gary Gaspard (“Candidate”) filed Nomination Papers for the office of Mayor of the City of Evanston. The Candidate’s petitions were objected to by William Arndt (“Objector”) and an initial hearing was held before the Municipal Officers Electoral Board of the City of Evanston (“Board”) to rule on those objections.

II. STATEMENT OF FACTS

Objector is a resident and registered voter in the City of Evanston, Cook County, Illinois. Objector properly filed an objection to the nominating petitions of the Candidate. The Board convened on December 12, 2016 and heard from Objector’s counsel. The Candidate did not appear before the Board at the scheduled call of the matter. The Board heard a short summation

from the Objector and then asked that the Objector file a memorandum in support of the objection.

Current Requirement for a Mayoral Primary for the City of Evanston

The City of Evanston ("City") has chosen to implement a mayoral primary. The City effectuated that choice by placing a binding referenda ("Referendum") on the ballot at the November 3, 1992 General Election. On August 24, 1992, the City Council of the City of Evanston met and approved Resolution 59-R-92. The Resolution provided that the following binding referendum be certified to the Cook County Clerk to be placed on the November 3, 1992 ballot:

"Shall the Mayor of the City of Evanston be elected in the following manner commencing with the election to be held in 1993 and after: If more than two candidates for Mayor shall have filed for election, a primary shall be held and the two candidates for Mayor receiving the highest number of votes shall stand for election in the Regular Election, Except if one candidate shall receive more than fifty percent (50%) of the votes cast at the primary, that candidate shall have been elected Mayor for a term commencing the first City Council meeting after the Regular Election?" (See attached Exhibit A)

The City Council took the further step, at that same meeting, to pass:

Resolution 69-R-92. – Providing for Nomination Petitions for the Office of Mayor

– Establishing a September 15 date as the first date to circulate petitions for the Office of Mayor, *pursuant to the Referendum to establish a Mayoral Primary.*

(Emphasis added, See Exhibit A)

These filing dates coincide with the filing dates established by the Illinois Election Code for a primary election to be held in 1993, clearly indicating that the City Council intended, upon the passing of the binding referendum, that a primary was to be held. Further, that the City Council took this step, at that same meeting, indicates their clear understanding that once the Referendum passed, there would be a primary for every mayoral election moving forward. The Referendum was passed by the voters at the November 3, 1992 General Election and established the primary process for election of all future City of Evanston mayors. (See attached Exhibit B)

The Candidate's Invalid Nomination Petition

The Candidate filed nominating petitions for the April 4, 2017 Consolidated Election. The Candidate's nominating packet, consisting of his Statement of Candidacy, Loyalty Oath, receipt for filing of the Statement of Economic Interests, and nominating petitions. Candidates petitions fail to indicate that he is a candidate for election at the February 28, 2017 Consolidated Primary Election. The Candidate's nominating petitions, placed before the voters, indicate that he is a candidate for office at the April 4, 2017 Consolidated Election. The Illinois Election Code, 10 ILCS 5/10-5 requires that the petition sheets take substantially the following form:

I,...., being first duly sworn, say that I reside at.... street, in the city (or village) of.... in the county of.... State of Illinois; and that I am a qualified voter therein; **that I am a candidate for election to the office of.... to be voted upon at the election to be held on the.... day of.....;** and that I am legally qualified to hold such office and that I have filed (or will file before the close of the petition filing period) a statement of economic interests as required by the Illinois Governmental Ethics Act, and I hereby request that my name be printed upon the official ballot for election to such office. (Emphasis added)

Candidate is required to place the date of the Consolidated Primary Election on his petitions and has failed to do so. Candidate's Statement of Candidacy also fails to reference the February 28, 2017 Consolidated Primary Election. While several other candidates filed appropriate nominating petitions for the Consolidated Primary Election, the Candidate filed incorrectly for the Consolidated Primary Election. Unlike those candidates, the Candidate here, placed information before the registered voters of the City of Evanston asking them to place him on the ballot for the April 4th Consolidated Election. This is not something that the voters can do. The primary process that was adopted by the City does not allow the Board to overrule the will of the people by forgoing a Consolidated Primary Election.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner-Objector prays that his Objector's Petition be granted, that the Board find that the nomination petition of Gary Gaspard be found to be invalid, and that Respondent-Candidate's name not be printed on the February 28, 2017 Consolidated Primary Election ballot for election to the office of Mayor of the City of Evanston.

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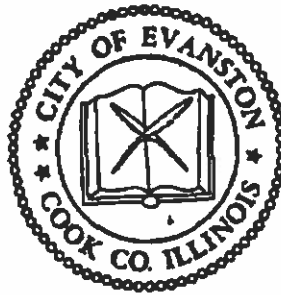

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Mayor Barr announced that she was changing the order of the meeting to consider something that was not on the agenda. She said that a fine public servant, Shel Newberger, had died last week and at this time she would like Council to consider a Resolution commemorating his life and public service.

August 24, 1992

Alderman Feldman moved Suspension of the Rules in order to consider Resolution 68-R-92, not on the Council agenda. Seconded by Alderman Warshaw. Motion carried.
No nays.

Alderman Feldman read Resolution 68-R-92, Upon the death of Shel Newberger. It was seconded by Alderman Warshaw and adopted by the Council standing and observing a moment of silence on behalf of Shel Newberger.

Alderman Feldman added his own personal recollections of Mr. Newberger. (A copy of his comments is on file with the permanent minutes.)

Mayor Barr thanked Alderman Feldman for his eloquent words memorializing Mr. Newberger and noted that Mr. Newberger had served on this Council and had served the City and Community in many capacities. He will be missed by his friends and colleagues. She presented the Resolution to his family and said that she hopes this public gesture of appreciation will convey to them how much this very public man will be missed.

CITY MANAGER ANNOUNCEMENTS:

City Manager Eric A. Anderson announced that Monday, September 7, Labor Day, will be a parking holiday and the Monday refuse collection will be picked up on Tuesday and the Tuesday refuse collection will be picked up on Wednesday. The rest of the week's collection will remain the same.

CITIZEN COMMENT:

Bill Crotty, 2719 Hartzell Street, a member of Northwestern University faculty specializing in elections and primaries, spoke in favor of requiring that a candidate for Mayor get a 50% majority of votes cast in an election because such a change would be in the best interest of all; it would provide for a more representative electoral process; democratic government is an effort to represent the views of the greatest number of people and elections are the key to the process. He said such a primary would help weed out candidates whose views are out of the mainstream and who have a strong but narrow base of support. When you go to a primary system it's easier for people to get information and, in his experience, it increases the turnout. Primaries are designed to choose the finalists, not to make the final choice. Since Evanston City government is undergoing a fundamental change in the next year, this would be a good time to change the electoral system to make it more responsive of the community and would be the fairest and safest approach to identify areas of discontent. He said he did not believe that it would prevent a minority candidate (black) from being elected, but would hurt those political minorities out of the mainstream; such a system would allow coalition building and permit African-Americans to get the type of representation over the long run that they desire.

Elizabeth Wilson, 1801 Asbury Avenue, President of Dewey Community Conference, spoke on behalf of its Executive Committee and expressed concerns about the last meeting of the Economic Development Committee concerning the Washington National Site Project. She said that there was not yet enough public information about the project and objected to having only five days to review the information given at the meeting. She questioned whether there was enough information to endorse the concept and suggested that Council would be acting in haste if they adopted the resolution before them this evening. She also questioned references in the Resolution to the new Zoning Ordinance, when it is expected to be adopted before this

project is in the final planning stage. She also urged Council to take a look at the effect a high-rise building would have on the low-rise buildings in the neighborhood and how it would fit into the Comprehensive General Plan for Evanston. She expressed concern that Chicago Avenue was turning into a glass and concrete canyon and urged Council to consider all the issues before adopting the concept.

David Sanders, 543 Judson Avenue, an architect and Chair of the Zoning Committee of the Southeast Evanston Neighbors (SEEN), said he had been following the development of the new Zoning Ordinance and was surprised that it was being referenced in this Resolution because it has not yet been adopted. He urged that adoption of the Resolution be postponed until such time as Council has taken a careful look and considered all the issues. He called attention to the packet of information developed by the Dewey Community Conference that had been put on the aldermen's desks that evening and asked that they read it and acquaint themselves with the impact of what is being asked of them.

MINUTES:

Alderman Warshaw moved that the minutes of the Regular Meeting of August 10, 1992, as submitted in writing to members of the City Council, be approved without reading. Seconded by Alderman Feldman. Motion carried. No nays.

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Alderman Rainey reported that review of the five finalists on this project had been an exhaustive and intensive process undertaken by Aldermen, representatives of the Library Board, City Manager Anderson, Library Director Ney, Director of Building Operations Rubin and representatives of U.S. Equities, the City's Project Manager for the library. She said all five companies had made aggressive efforts to obtain approval but that W.E. O'Neil won out on the basis that they had just completed building a new state-of-the-art library at DePaul University and their whole project team for that project will be Evanston's project team. She also reported that their Minority Business Enterprise/Women Business Enterprise (MBE/WBE) efforts on the DePaul project are well documented.

Alderman Drummer said that he was delighted that the W.E. O'Neil Company was receiving this award and was also pleased to see the documentation provided on their previous MBE/WBE efforts. He said that he hoped that in the future all contractors would provide the same sort of information, because any contractor working on public projects is subject to our MBE/WBE requirements. He congratulated the committee and staff and said that it was very much the way we want it to go.

Alderman Rainey added that because this is such an important community project, the O'Neil company had agreed to hold local contractor meetings to reach out to local minority contractors and to divide large jobs in such a way as to make them manageable for small firms, especially Evanston contractors. She said these meetings would be well publicized.

Alderman Drummer said that this is not something the contractor should attempt to do by himself, but to work with the MBE Coordinator, which he hoped would be on-board very soon.

Alderman Washington sought assurances that the contractors would be hiring Evanston residents. Alderman Rainey said she assumed that small Evanston contractors would be Evanston people and assured her that the best effort will be made to make it the most community-involved project.

Alderman Newman expressed sympathy for Alderman Washington's concern and asked for staff assurances that they would continually monitor these efforts and push for the hiring of Evanston residents. He said this is a major project and we need as many people in Evanston employed by this project as possible.

Alderman Rainey pointed out the owner of the company is Evanston-born and raised and assured Council that he was very committed to involving minorities and other community members in this project.

This docket item was held in committee.

Alderman Warshaw reported that the Planning & Development Committee had begun discussion of payments-in-lieu-of-taxes. She also reported that the committee was expecting to receive the most recent version of the new Zoning Ordinance from the consultant in the coming week. She said the committee was expecting to conduct a final analysis of the ordinance beginning October 5 and hoped to complete it by the end of the year.

HUMAN SERVICES COMMITTEE:

Alderman Drummer reported that the committee had begun discussion on the Reference from Alderman Newman concerning ACORN and had appointed a sub-committee of Aldermen Moran, Washington and Fiske and would possibly add Aldermen Kent and Newman to the sub-committee to work with the neighborhood group and discuss issues germane to ACORN. They had also asked staff to investigate how ACORN deals with other agencies. The committee will come back with the charge at the next meeting for the sub-committee.

OTHER COMMITTEES:

Docket 203-8B-92: Resolution 67-R-92 - Endorsement of Exploration of Redevelopment of the Washington National Site - Consideration of proposed Resolution 67-R-92, by which the City Council would endorse the exploration of the redevelopment project as proposed by The John Buck Company for the redevelopment of the Washington National site; consideration of the concept of a tax growth contract; and the application for a Planned Development.

Alderman Nelson, Chair of the Economic Development Committee, said he would like Council to consider this Resolution tonight, but not adopt it. He encouraged Council to study the text of the Resolution and to raise any questions or suggest any changes they felt were appropriate. He said that his primary goal this evening was to proceed with the exploration of the project and hear what the developer was proposing; the secondary goal was to consider the timing for Council to proceed in an expeditious, fair and measured fashion so they can let the developer know by the end of the year whether the City endorses the project and whether it is worthwhile to proceed. He suggested that Council members share their concerns and questions with Assistant City Manager Aiello and asked her to conduct the presentation.

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Alderman Newman questioned the reference in the Resolution to the proposed Zoning Ordinance and moved to amend it to strike the word "proposed." Seconded by Alderman Nelson.

Alderman Davis said that this same question had been asked of her by some citizens and she clarified that the only real reference to the proposed ordinance was not to standards, but to the timetable of 90-days, and suggested that there was no need to make any reference to the proposed Zoning Ordinance in the Resolution.

Alderman Nelson moved Council adoption of proposed Resolution 67-R-92. Seconded by Alderman Drummer.

Alderman Davis moved to amend the Resolution in Section 4, page two, to delete everything following the words "90-days" in line three and four.

Assistant City Manager Aiello opened the presentation by explaining that last Wednesday the Economic Development Committee had received a presentation by representatives of Washington National Insurance Company and the John Buck Company and were asked to request that Council initiate the exploration of the project. She explained that the genesis of the project began some months ago with the decision of Washington National Insurance Company (WNI) to leave Evanston. When WNI selected a developer to develop the site, a discussion with the City was initiated, and in March there was a preliminary meeting with the neighbors. She explained that at that time it was assumed that the new Zoning Ordinance would be in place when it came time to request a Planned Unit Development for this site. Since then the Zoning Ordinance has undergone considerable revision and the whole downtown section of the ordinance has undergone significant change. The preliminary analysis of the project will be done under the old Zoning Ordinance and then another analysis may be undertaken when the new Zoning Ordinance is adopted.

The preliminary design of the project reflects comments and concerns expressed by the neighbors. The developer also reported to the City concerns that were raised during preliminary discussions with financial institutions on the issue of taxes in Evanston and those concerns have led to the development of the tax growth concept. The City has discussed the concept with the two school districts and has encouraged them to explore whether they would be able to legally agree to such a contract. Representatives of the school districts have been asked to consider a presentation on the project and the tax growth concept for their boards, hopefully in September.

Ms. Aiello introduced John Iberle, Senior Vice President of the Buck Company, who explained that the John Buck Company has formed a partnership with Washington National Insurance Company to redevelop their headquarters site when it is vacated by WNI. He introduced the other representatives of the John Buck Company and turned the podium over to Tom Pontarelli, who in addition to being Executive Vice President for Law and Administration for WNI, also headed the WNI relocation study.

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Mr. Pontarelli explained that there had been approximately a 20-month period following a significant downsizing at WNI and the sale of four of their associated businesses when they examined their space needs and the viability of their current site. In 1990 they retained the firm of Julian J. Studley, real estate consultants, to analyze their headquarter's options. They explored four options: to renovate the existing structure; to demolish the existing structure and build new; to relocate to space in the NBD Bank Building (which they own); or whether they should relocate to another location in Evanston or elsewhere. In April 1990, they retained an architectural firm to engage in a crosscheck of analyses they had previously done on the structural integrity and viability of their existing facilities and also to study what the space needs actually were in their downsized environment. In June 1990 the consultant told them that to properly occupy the site for the next 10 to 15 years would cost in excess of \$10 million in renovation costs and the building is more than 100,000 square feet too large for their current and future needs. The consultant also determined that converting the building to multi-tenant use would be cost-prohibitive. During July through October, 1990, thirteen developers were approached to build a new headquarters building on that site. The response was overwhelmingly of no interest to develop a commercial-use from that site because it was felt it would not be competitive to finance an office building in that location in downtown Evanston. The Charles Shaw Company responded with a proposal to build on another Evanston site. Most of the other developers responded that the only financial use of that site would be residential use. He also explained that the proposal to move into the NBD Bank Building was studied, but eventually rejected because there was not enough space available for their needs. In early 1991 a number of developers were approached about a straight sale of the site, however, no developers were interested but several came back with a proposal for a joint venture to develop the site. After an exhaustive study between June and November 1991, WNI became convinced the John Buck Company had a vision for this site and a commitment to the type of quality project that Evanston deserved.

Greg Murdinger of the John Buck Company assumed the podium and said that the project is challenging because of the site, which is located at the edge of an urban downtown area, but adjacent to an architecturally significant, affluent neighborhood and world-renowned University. He said that Evanston is known to be a vocal community, which will add additional challenges to the zoning process. It is also one of the healthiest real estate markets in the country, close to excellent mass transit and Lake Michigan. A market study revealed that their target market will be about 30% University students and staff occupying the smaller units lower down; young urban professionals; and the remaining group will be empty nesters who will want to stay on the North Shore.

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He explained that the site was approximately 200 by 400 feet and that to provide the amenities their target market would desire, they need to develop a building of approximately 300 units in phase one. After a preliminary discussion held with neighbors, they determined that it would be desirable to provide a garage for tenants that is set back as far from Chicago Avenue as possible and also understood the importance of preserving green space. To accomplish this, they designed the project as a 32-story tower (which will be slightly taller than the NBD Bank Building) to take advantage of the vistas of the lake and the city with 25,000 square feet of commercial space on the front and a 300-space garage on the rear of the property. Phase two of the project is currently visualized as a 200-unit building which will be built on the northwest corner of the site as the market permits (during his presentation, Alderman Warshaw assumed the Chair for Mayor Barr for approximately five minutes.). He reviewed the project and how it addresses the market segments they are trying to reach.

John Iberle continued the presentation with discussion of the tax growth concept. He explained that the motivating factor behind the concept is that commercial real estate is in a depression today. During preliminary discussions with potential lenders, specific concerns have been raised by them about real estate taxes on the North Shore and they indicated that property taxes in Evanston are a wild card. The tax growth contract, as being presented, will assure the lenders and the Evanston taxing bodies of an equitable means of generating additional taxes over time. The viability of the project is contingent on establishing some level of certainty on real estate taxes. Mr. Iberle continued his presentation by explaining the tax growth concept using various charts and graphs and he clarified that it would be a direct arrangement among the developer, the City and the two school districts, with no involvement of the County Assessor's office. He requested that Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate the tax growth concept with them and indicated that they will be pursuing zoning approvals during the same time frame in order to put themselves in a position to begin the project when Washington National Insurance Company vacates the site next summer.

In response to a question from Alderman Rainey, Mr. Iberle explained that WNI's sole obligation to the partnership is to contribute property. Mr. Murdinger estimated that phase one of the project would cost around \$40 million, exclusive of land. He said it would be difficult to estimate the cost of the land, because land values on the North Shore were significantly different from those in downtown Chicago.

Alderman Rainey expressed concern with the tax growth contract assumptions that the project should be valued the same per unit as the units in Evanston Place. She asked for an explanation on how the pieces fit together for the taxes on the parking spaces that are reserved for residents in the Evanston Place project. She requested to know who pays the taxes and how taxes are determined on the parking spaces. She also requested a pro forma on how much money the developer will make on this project - the revenue and expenses for a fifteen year period.

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Assistant City Manager Aiello said she would be happy to provide answers to these questions and any others the Council may have. To answer Alderman Rainey's first question, she explained that the City sold the air rights for Evanston Place to the Rescorp Company and there is a complex subdivision of multiple tax parcels on the property. She said this coming month will be the first time the City will have full tax year information on the property and will be providing that information to City Council.

Alderman Engelman said that he had no problem with the tax growth concept, but was not sure it should be tied to Evanston Place. He said that the first determination Council needs to make is to decide whether this community should make some type of contribution to this project, which is a private venture, and will not (long term) create jobs or increase sales tax. He felt that it was important to have the costs of acquisition, demolition and cost of building this project, as well as the costs of rents so Council can see if it makes economic sense. We need the pro forma information to be convinced we need to be involved. We also need to know what benefits will come to the City if it is converted to condominiums.

Alderman Newman expressed concern that there is no pro forma yet at this stage. He also expressed confusion about what was happening with the proposed zoning analysis and questioned whether it was the intent of the developer to go through it once or twice and which zoning ordinance would be used. He asked what would happen if the Assessor's office valued the units at more than the \$1,722 proposed in the tax growth concept.

Assistant City Manager Aiello explained that there are a number of issues that could change the pro forma for this project, so staff had decided not to undertake extensive review until they had a sense whether the Economic Development Committee and Council endorsed the concept of the project. Another issue that needs to be cleared up is whether the school district can legally enter into a contract such as is proposed in the Tax Growth Concept. This project will require extensive analyses and computer modeling and until they had a sense of the Council, they did not want to commit to the time required. She promised to obtain a legal opinion as to which Zoning Ordinance the project would be using.

Alderman Warshaw said she supported getting more information on the project and asked whether the tax figures presented reflect 300 units or 500 units.

Mr. Iberle explained that the concept reflects three stages of development of the property - the departure of Washington National Insurance Company, the development of Phase 1 and of Phase 2. He said that they expect to start Phase 2 approximately 12-months after completion of Phase 1, but cautioned that the development of Phase 2 would be as difficult as Phase 1. In answer to a question from Alderman Davis, he confirmed that there were alternate concepts of what to do for Phase 2. Perhaps developing the site as townhouses or as a mid-rise and townhouses. They had not analyzed that possibility as part of the tax growth contract.

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Alderman Davis also commented that one of the problems with the project was the high cost of demolition, since rehabbing or reusing was cost-prohibitive. She pointed out that the questions being raised on the Council floor were also raised in the Economic Development Committee. She urged Council to read the resolution carefully and to consider what they are actually being asked to adopt.

Alderman Paden said she had received comment from citizens about the height of the building and asked whether the developer could show how the height was related to the amount of income coming into the City. She said that the neighbors didn't like the mass and felt it was too costly for Evanston. She asked how much money will Evanston lose and how long will it take it get it back? Citizens are saying that they pay big taxes, why shouldn't the developer pay big taxes when they are bigger and more powerful than the average citizen. They wonder why developers' taxes should be cut when citizens' taxes are not. Citizens also need to know how long Evanston is losing taxes and how that will affect their tax bills. She suggested that the developer needs to expand on a lot of these things and explain why it is worthwhile to people before she will support the project.

Mr. Iberle responded that the height solution resulted from community comment about the desire for open space, rather than developing a building that went out to the lot lines. He said that it would be possible to build a lower project, but it would be more like Evanston Place. It is possible that the tax growth contract may have no cost to Evanston citizens, because the cost is a function of the general rate of growth in taxes. What the developer is asking is for tax growth at a lesser rate comparable to Evanston Place, or 3% per year. If regular property taxes grow at that rate, there would be no cost to the City, it would only cost the City if taxes increased dramatically.

Alderman Nelson reiterated Alderman Davis's comments that the resolution is only a commitment to explore the concept, not a commitment to the project. He said that answers need to be provided to questions raised by Aldermen Rainey, Paden and others in order to answer the question raised by Alderman Engelman, whether the City should commit to this project. Council also has to decide whether the timing is realistic, whether it can complete its exploration process within three or four months and give the developer an indication whether it is willing to commit to the project at that time. He also urged Council to hold a Public Hearing during the latter part of their deliberations. The tax proposal is just a proposal - based on a formulation associated with Evanston Place, which is next door, but it may be entirely the wrong approach or concept. It may be that the tax contract should be tied to the developer's cash flow or there may be other more appropriate formulations.

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Alderman Newman said that what had been presented to the Economic Development Committee was a proposal to endorse the concept and to endorse the tax contract. He said it was he who had amended the recommendation to the way it was presented this evening. He said that perhaps citizens and community members were confused because the resolution did not get to Council in advance of the meeting. He suggested that information be sent to Council before meetings. He also asked whether marketing research had indicated whether the building would draw tenants from Evanston Place and commented on the apparent incompatibility between students and other tenants and asked whether it would work to mix them within the same building.

Mr. Murdinger said that the question had been raised whether residential improvements work as a downtown amenity. He said that downtown residential places create a vibrance in an area that is motivated by residents who buy goods and services. He suggested that the tax concept that they are asking for is really "somewhere in the basement" as far as subsidies go and Council should look at developments in Milwaukee, Baltimore, Cleveland, Cincinnati, et cetera to understand that they are not looking for rebates or subsidies but certainty about the level of taxes. He reported that he had done some quick calculations and Council would be taking \$50 out of each household in taxes if they don't grant the tax contract and the property remains vacant. He explained that it is important to pursue this expeditiously while they have a cooperative owner and interest rates are low. He said there will be a 3.5 million dollar initial return on the 9% cost of capital, which means that the developer will just about break even. If rates drop lower, there will be a little better return. Specific numbers have not been provided because pricing on the building is not in, but should be between \$65 and \$70 per square foot. He also explained that the tax proposal was generated by two lenders and the developers were counting on Alderman Newman to come up with a third. He said that they didn't know about "market death" and that there were no promises about Phase 2. He said they may build commercial or townhomes. He explained that some people may consider students a negative in an upscale building, but the apartments are segregated by economic level. He said that they have had a good experience with this kind of mix in downtown buildings that they have developed and pointed out that it is more of a management problem. He also pointed out that Evanston Place is approximately 30% university related.

Alderman Heydemann asked whether the tax concept was unique or whether it had been used before.

Mr. Murdinger said that a Tax Increment Financing District was a similar concept and he was aware of a project in Indianapolis that had used a 10-year staged abatement process which began with paying 10% of the regular tax bill in the first year and working up to 100% in the 10th year. He suggested that this tax growth proposal is reasonably revenue neutral.

Alderman Drummer questioned why the developer felt it was necessary to get a \$20,000 subsidy for a \$40 million project and wondered whether it would work against the project.

Mr. Iberle explained that the concept was the certainty of taxes over time.

Alderman Drummer also raised the question of how the developer planned to satisfy the City's MBE/WBE requirements.

Mr. Murdinger responded that, while it had never been required of them for previous projects, they had always been committed to providing MBE jobs.

Alderman Drummer reiterated his request for information on this requirement.

Alderman Rainey asked what plans there were to set aside units for low income housing in the building.

Alderman Paden moved to hold over the Resolution until the next Council meeting. Seconded by Alderman Kent. At the request of two aldermen, this docket item will be held over until the next meeting.

OTHER COMMITTEES:

Docket 187-7B-92: Resolution 59-R-92 - Binding Referendum on Mayoral Elections - Consideration of proposed Resolution 59-R-92, by which the City Council would place a Binding Referendum on the November 1992 General Election Ballot which, if approved by the voters, would require a run-off election if no Mayoral candidate received 50 percent or more of the votes cast for that office.

Alderman Drummer moved to take Resolution 59-R-92 off the table. Seconded by Alderman Warshaw. Motion carried. No nays.

Alderman Drummer expressed his continuing opposition to the resolution, in spite of the comments of the Northwestern University professor during Citizen Comment, and disagreed with his comments about voting in the South. Alderman Drummer felt that the fairest way to proceed with a primary would be to hold partisan primaries. He said that if 67% of the voters of Evanston are supposed to be Democratic and they cannot get their candidate elected, then there must be something else wrong other than election procedures. He also suggested that no one would go out and "cut deals" after the primaries. He suggested that Evanston minorities could have affected the outcome of the Mikva/Porter elections for Congress if they had understood how to "cut a deal." He reminded Council that only two candidates ran for Mayor at the last election, reviewed the results of several Mayoral elections before that, and urged Council to vote "no" on this referendum question.

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Alderman Warshaw moved to amend Resolution 59-R-92 to have the Referendum question read: "Shall the Mayor of the City of Evanston be elected in the following manner commencing with the election to be held in 1993 and thereafter: If more than two candidates for Mayor shall have filed for election, a primary shall be held and the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes shall stand for election in the Regular Election, Except if one candidate shall receive more than fifty percent (50%) of the votes cast at the primary, that candidate shall have been elected Mayor for a term commencing the first City Council meeting after the Regular Election?"

Seconded by Alderman Feldman.

Alderman Warshaw commended legal staff for all the work they had done on this Referendum question to make it more understandable. Vote on the amendment. Motion carried. No nays.

Alderman Warshaw reiterated her support for the Resolution and said that it is a real reflection of democracy and a welcome change. She reported that citizens had talked to her about the Referendum and they were in favor of it. She urged Council not to vote on the substance of the Resolution, but to vote to allow citizens the opportunity to vote on the Referendum question in November. Roll call. Voting aye - Kent, Wollin, Engelman, Rainey, Feldman, Warshaw, Newman, Paden, Davis, Heydemann, Washington. Voting nay - Nelson, Moran, Fiske, Drummer, Esch. Motion carried. (11-5).

Mayor Barr called attention to the additional Resolution put on aldermen's desks that evening to address complications with circulating petitions that will be created by the just-adopted Referendum.

In answer to questions from Alderman Warshaw, First Assistant Corporation Counsel Hill replied that this was a well-researched resolution that was a component part of the resolution just adopted, which provides that Evanston have a uniform process consistent with the state for the circulation of petitions for the primary election. He explained that state election law requires that all elections be uniform and general. This resolution will make sure the Evanston electoral process and the circulation of petitions for the primary will be uniform with the state requirements. While it is not required to be adopted immediately, he advised that it be adopted this evening because of its connection with 59 R-92. In response to a question from Alderman Engelman, Mr. Hill explained that if Council does not adopt this resolution, the City could be subject to a substantial challenge as to the Constitutionality of the Referendum question.

Alderman Feldman moved to Suspend the Rules in order to consider something not on the agenda. Seconded by Alderman Drummer. Motion carried. No nays.

Docket 204-88-92: Resolution 69-R-92 - Providing for Nominating Petitions for the Office of Mayor - Establishing a September 15 date as the first date to circulate petitions for the Office of Mayor, pursuant to the Referendum to establish a Mayoral Primary.

Alderman Feldman moved Council adoption of proposed Resolution 69-R-92. Seconded by Alderman Rainey. Motion carried.

*Docket 195-8A-92: Resolution 65-R-92 - Board, Commission, & Committee Meetings - Consideration of proposed Resolution 65-R-92, by which the City Council would amend City Council Rules to specify that any three or more members of a Committee, Board, or Commission may call a meeting of that body if the Chairman has cancelled the meeting. In accordance with City Council Rule 3.1, which requires that any change in City Council Rules be distributed at least one week in advance of the Vote on the change, this item is scheduled for City Council. * ADOPTED - CONSENT AGENDA MOTION AND ROLL CALL. (16-0).

Alderman Drummer moved confirmation of these appointments. Seconded by Alderman Nelson. Motion carried. No nays.

MAYORAL ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Mayor Barr reported that she had recently learned of the death of someone who was very important in the history of the City - Bert W. Johnson, Evanston's first City Manager from December 1953 to December 1962. She asked that everyone rise and observe a moment of silence in memory of Mr. Johnson.

CALL OF THE WARDS:

Alderman Warshaw commented that Shel Newberger had been Alderman of the 9th Ward when she moved into her home. She said he was part of Evanston history and will be missed.

Alderman Wollin said that the City of Evanston owes a great debt of gratitude to Gus Giordano, the World Jazz Congress and the Theatre Department of Northwestern University for their week's activity and dance. She reported that she had been at the culminating performance last Saturday and said that it was a wonderful, energized room full of young, very thin dancers and she had a wonderful time. She said it brought enormous economic benefits to Evanston as well as the culture and art they contributed to the community. She thanked Northwestern University and Gus Giordano for bringing this event to Evanston.

August 24, 1992

Alderman Wollin also thanked all those who were kind during the recent unexpected complications from surgery and reported that she had watched the last meeting on TV and said that she was extraordinarily uncomfortable with the debate on the Masuret appointment. She said that she appreciated the Mayor's memo clarifying what had happened and reported that she had come into view the videotape of the July 27 meeting to make sure that she had remembered correctly what had occurred. It was clear to her that Alderman Rainey had asked that the appointment of Ms. Masuret be held so that she could have a chance to talk to her and discuss the questions she had raised on the Council floor. Knowing how thorough Alderman Rainey is, she said that it did not dawn on her that Alderman Rainey would not have made that call or asked those questions of Ms. Masuret that she wanted answered. She understood that she could not ask for reconsideration because she was not present to vote at the last meeting, but she felt the Council had done an enormous disservice to a person who was unfortunate enough to have her appointment caught up in the middle of philosophical debate. That person's character was maligned and the comments made bordered on character defamation. Very derogatory terms were used on what should have been a routine reappointment to a board. Alderman Wollin felt that the Council owes a public apology to Joanne Masuret for the way in which her character was publicly maligned when she had served the City well. This is not the way to treat one of our citizens.

Alderman Rainey made reference to the transcript provided with the Mayor's memo and said that she read it very differently from Alderman Wollin. She said that the questions she raised concerning Levy Center and the loan guarantee are in the transcript and never in her wildest intentions had she meant to solicit the answers to those questions for the City Council. She said that Joanne Masuret was on a board where aldermen do not receive minutes and have no oversight, so she had no idea whether Masuret had served the City well and neither did any other member of Council unless they talked to her. She said that she had asked for a response to her questions and she had been told that it was her job to get it, but pointed out that it was her vote that was being asked for. She said she was happy that Ms. Masuret had not responded because now there was a vacancy on the board and she felt that she would have better leverage to get someone appointed to the RPI Board who represented her point of view. She suggested that the Mayor and supporters of Ms. Masuret had dropped the ball on the appointment. It is not the job of an adversary to go out and make things right for a nominee, it is the obligation of the Mayor and other supporters. It is they who should get the blame.

Mayor Barr responded that the key to her was Alderman Rainey's statement that she would talk to Ms. Masuret.

Alderman Rainey said nowhere in the transcript did it say she would call Ms. Masuret.

August 24, 1992

Alderman Nelson said he would like to rise in defense of Ms. Masuret and said that the question had been raised what kind of appointment was she to the RPI Board. He said she was an extremely credible, hardworking, competent representative of the City of Evanston on the RPI Board. He said Council could be proud of her service, of her contributions and proud of the work she did. It is a shame on all of us to point fingers in every direction, that she became a "cause celebre" for other agenda. She was a fine appointment and he regretted that she was not reappointed. He reiterated his offer, made previously, if anyone has questions about the RPI Board to give him a call and he will be happy to answer the question or to find out the information.

Alderman Heydemann reported on the most recent meeting of the First Night Committee with Honorary Co-Chairs Drew Davis of the Pioneer Press and Mayor Barr. She said that the celebration would not take place in 1992, but would be held December 31, 1993. She alerted the Council that they would be receiving invitations soon to a kickoff reception on October 14 that would give the event a lot of publicity and urged a lot of people to volunteer. She said that when they have a successful celebration it will be the result of a lot of work by a lot of people. The reception will be at 6:00 P.M. on October 14.

Alderman Esch reported she had received numerous complaints about newspaper boxes and she realized that control over them is tied into certain First Amendment questions. However she reported that the 13 boxes between the two railroad tracks on Main Street, eight had been unused for weeks, some were broken and some had trash and out-of-date publications and are unsightly. She said she did not believe these could be protected under the First Amendment and urged staff to research getting rid of some of these unused, unsightly boxes.

Alderman Drummer offered his condolences to the Newberger family, saying that he was a good man and he had had a very good relationship with him. Alderman Drummer reported that last Friday was the last game of the Mason Park Summer League. He said the program had been very successful and had ended with a family party. He said the Council would be getting a report soon from the Recreation Department on the program.

Alderman Paden reminded Council that on Wednesday, September 2, there would be a community meeting at the Fleetwood-Jourdain Center to discuss crime, drug and gangs with the Police Chief and the Police Department at 7:30 P.M.

Alderman Newman reminded Alderman Drummer that he will be taking the issue of the sale of 1817 Church Street off the table at the September 21 meeting and hoped that all committee comments would be complete. He announced that the Noyes Street Business Association and the Noyes Cultural Arts Center will hold a festival on Sunday, September 20, and invited all to attend.

Alderman Newman offered his personal condolences to the Newberger family. He said that Shel Newberger typified what is best about Evanston. He truly cared about this community. Alderman Newman said he appreciated that Mr. Newberger went against all the other former aldermen of the First Ward and supported him for alderman at the last election. He said that he appreciated the support and the telephone calls after he had been elected.

August 24, 1992

Alderman Newman said he felt that he had to comment on some of the other comments made concerning the Masuret reappointment to the RPI Board. He said that some people "just don't get it" and blame others for their mistakes. They attempt to blame others because they have not brought all 18 members of the Council into the formulation of decisions and policy surrounding the Research Park. They blame others when they did not bother to pick up the phone. He suggested that Aldermen Wollin and Nelson have no one else to blame and because they get what they want out of this Mayor, they don't have to come to the rest of us. Because they also get what they want on the Research Park, they don't bother to talk to the rest of us. He said he supposed the Mayor and aldermen are going to learn a lesson that this is a body of 18 people. He said that if he had such a close relationship with the Mayor, he could get appointment the chair of the committee that he wanted on boards and commission, then perhaps he would be an advocate for a process where he could get what he wanted. He suggested that things have changed and now all eighteen aldermen have to be listened to and brought into the process. Nobody did any disservice to Joanne Masuret, she chose to enter her name into a public process. He suggested that when Alderman Wollin is a candidate for Mayor, people will ask her questions, make comments and not all agree with her. He said there was no defamation of Ms. Masuret and that her appointment was rejected because of a situation with politics and said that if people were on the other end of that (situation) they would have a different point of view. He stated that he did not regret his vote on that reappointment and urged the Mayor to work with all the aldermen about appointments, because her point of view was not the point of view of the majority of this City.

Alderman Fiske said, that while he was appointed an Alderman by the Mayor, it does not mean he agrees with every other appointment she makes, although he recognizes her great wisdom in appointing him. He did not feel the friendship and respect demonstrated by his appointment entitles him to "carte blanche" as far as appointments of other people go. He said that the way to have an appointment favorably considered is to offer it in a positive, non-combative manner. He recommended the use of harmonious tactics, with clear and open purposes, instead of a fighting stance such as we were treated to this evening.

Alderman Fiske also made reference to the recent Dance Congress held in Evanston. He said that he had attended the block party that opened the Congress. It was wonderful and a very positive experience for people who came to Evanston to be part of it and a way for them to learn to appreciate the City. He hoped it was an event that would happen again.

Alderman Heydemann said that since Alderman Newman was very concerned about the timing and disposition of the John Buck proposal and the Economic Development Committee, she wanted everyone to know that Alderman Newman drew up a redistricting map which substantially changed the configuration of the 4th Ward and did not contact her nor had he left a message on her answering machine when she returned. Since he is interested in openness and discussion, she would have appreciated a call. Alderman Newman said she didn't get a call because of her absence from the City and he felt no obligation to call her.

Mayor Barr requested that in future meetings that Aldermen display more decorum and civility toward each other. She said citizens expect it from us to them and they certainly expect it from us to each other.

August 24, 1992

Alderman Rainey moved Council go into CLOSED SESSION to consider pending litigation. Seconded by Alderman Nelson. Roll Call. Voting aye - Kent, Nelson, Moran, Wollin, Engelman, Rainey, Feldman, Warshaw, Fiske, Newman, Paden, Drummer, Davis, Esch, Heydemann, Washington. Voting nay - none. Motion carried. (16-0).

Council recessed into CLOSED SESSION at 12:25 A.M. and adjourned from CLOSED SESSION at 12:40 A.M.

Mayor raps contractor

Millions of public dollars and we don't have in most cases an Evanston resident work-
