This addendum forms a part of RFP # 24-23 and modifies these documents. This addendum consists of questions received.

Questions:

1. **Question:** Are all locations expected to be open year round?

Response: We are open to all proposals although the desire is for South End and Robert Crown to be open year-round with the rest of the locations seasonal.

2. Question: Are all sites conditioned (heated, AC, insulated)?

Response: Arrington Lagoon is just heated; James Park, Robert Crown, and South End are heated and air conditioned; Clark St has neither heating or air conditioning.

3. **Question:** Is the city able to purchase equipment / appliances?

Response: For the Arrington Lagoon there is a plan to purchase basic and customary equipment. South End and Robert Crown are furnished as is. James Park and Clark St will have freezers. Again, we are open to all options, requests, and if requests are made we will evaluate as part of the proposal as a whole.

4. Question: Will sites have WIFI?

Response: Robert Crown and South End have internet and there may be the ability to work off of that. The preference is for vendors to utilize a system that is cell based to avoid conflicts.
