City of Evanston 2024 MFT Street Resurfacing Project

Project Description

Over the next ten weeks, the City of Evanston will be contracting road resurfacing work on seven street segments throughout the City. This project involves curb replacement as needed, roadway base repair, replacement of asphalt surface from curb to curb along with selected ADA sidewalk replacement and driveway aprons. The funding for the project will be from the City's Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) Funds and there will be no direct charge for the property owners on these streets. The construction has been planned in two phases and the specific locations included in each phase of construction are listed below.

Construction on the phase 1 street segments will begin **the week of August 5** with the entire project expected to be fully completed by the **end of September** except the sodding. The actual date when construction is planned for your street will be noted on the temporary **NO PARKING** signs posted 48 hours prior to the start of work. The construction activities will create some inconvenience for abutting residents, but we will attempt to minimize these inconveniences. Construction zone daytime **NO PARKING** restrictions will be intermittent throughout the duration of the project; evening and nighttime parking (5:00pm to 7:00am) will always be available. Street sweeping and/or neighborhood parking restrictions will be waived for a one block radius around the construction zone when temporary daytime **NO PARKING** is in effect.
