- Pinkard suggests underpasses for pedestrians
- Protected bike lanes perhaps an option to address safety of bikes with trucks
- Pinkard are the sidewalks in good enough condition and wide enough for strollers, wheel chairs, kids walking to school, etc.
- Dykes suggested navigation on sidewalk is difficult for wheelchair users cant react quick enough at intersections - suggests to go in the street

- Mangum recommends plowing the the bike lanes
- Garcia recommends plowing the sidewalk
- Burns can we use TIF funds to plow sidewalks?
- Pinkard mobility policy / strategy will change with new Fifth Ward School.
- FioRito reminded committee that District 65 will be supporting alternative transportation to school (e.g. educational bike fleet)
- Flax look into banning right turn on red
